A paralegal by education and training and a graduate of Michigan State University's certificate program in Judicial Administration, Lisa Collins began her career with the Court of Appeals in 2002. She was appointed Clerk of Court in 2005. For her work assisting in the design and implementation of the Transcript Management System, Ms. Collins received the Record Quality Award from the Utah State Courts and the Justice Achievement Award (Honorable Mention) from the National Association of Court Managers in 2010. She has been a member of the NCACC since 2011 and has served on the Convention Service Committee, Awards Committee, Resolutions and Memorials Committee and Membership Committees of the NCACC.
