

## **Timothy Gudas Confirmed to Executive Committee**

Timothy Gudas, Deputy Clerk of the New Hampshire Supreme Court, has been confirmed to the Executive Committee of the National Conference of Appellate Court Clerks (NCACC).

Timothy Gudas has served as the Deputy Clerk at the New Hampshire Supreme Court since 2011. Prior to becoming Deputy Clerk, Mr. Gudas practiced civil and appellate litigation at Sulloway & Hollis in Concord, New Hampshire from 1997 to 2011. From 1996 to 1997, he served as a law clerk to Associate Justice Sherman D. Horton, Jr., of the New Hampshire Supreme Court. Mr. Gudas is a graduate of Dartmouth College and Boston College Law School.
